

**A GUIDE TO THE LITERATURE AND DISTRIBUTION OF
THE BENTHIC MARINE ALGAE IN CHILE ***

Part I. Chlorophyceae, Phaeophyceae

Chilean marine flora has been described in a great deal of publications and in various countries. Moreover, recently considerable changes in taxonomical nomenclature have occurred and these complicate the identification from earlier works. The aim of this work is to make a catalogue of the algological literature and at the same time to compile all the accepted generic and specific names concerning benthic marine algae in Chile.

This is not a complete guide. It was quite impossible to review all the existing literature and information which are badly scattered and largely inaccessible. The author, however, has tried to do his best in assembling here all the published records of determination and distribution of benthic marine algae in Chile.

Arrangements of the taxa are based on the publication of Parke and Dixon (1968), and great part of the literature concerning antarctic and subantarctic marine algae is introduced from Papenfuss (1964). The specific names of algae are alphabetically arranged in a genus, and its geographical distribution is arranged in the following order: Main land (from North to South including Antarctic region), Juan Fernandez Islands, San Ambrosio Island, San Felix Island and Easter Island. Many new places which could have been included in this work were eliminated because they have not yet been recorded in any publication. Only the recorded localities are shown with their respective literatures cited.

Species which are solely known from Juan Fernandez Islands, San Ambrosio Island and Easter Island, but not from the coast of the main land are marked with a "§".

Citation of all the relationated references to any given species has not been possible, but the references cited include the most indispensable ones, and will serve in each case as a key to the other literatures.

The present work contains 103 species of Chlorophyceae and 119 of Phaeophyceae. More information, if available, will be greatly welcomed, and Part II, Rhodophyceae, is expected to be published soon.

The elaboration of this work was possible through the facilities provided by several institutions and various persons. The author is very grateful to Professor Clodomiro Marticorena and Professor Mario Ricardi of the Department of Botany of the University of Concepcion for their kind suggestions in the course of this work.
